Racine – Mr. Guy Christensen, 62, passed away at home on Saturday, January 11, 2014 after fighting a courageous battle over pancreatic cancer for 17 months.

Guy was born in Racine to Carolyn (nee: Moeller) Bruno and the late Verne Christensen on January 11, 1952. Guy was united in marriage to Sherri (nee: Bush) on March 8, 1977.

He was a manufacturing supervisor at KMC in Port Washington. He was a hardworking and giving person devoted to his family. His children and grandchildren meant the world to him.
