The family would like to give special thanks to the staff of the Jewish Home and Care center for their compassionate care.

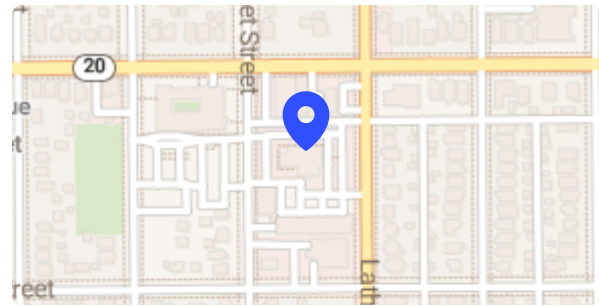

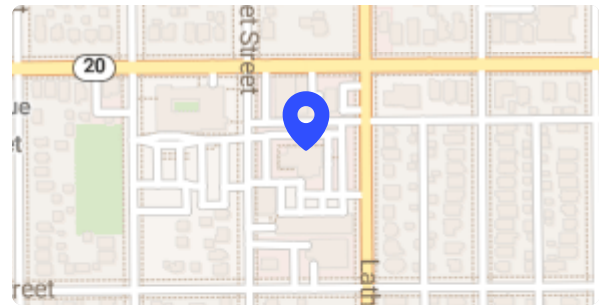

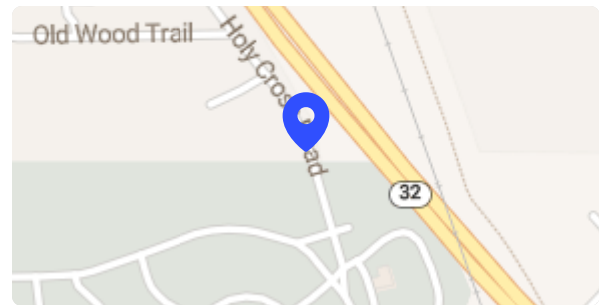
