RACINE- Richard N. Nelsen, 96, passed away on Thursday, May 28, 2015 at The Villa at Lincoln Park in Racine.

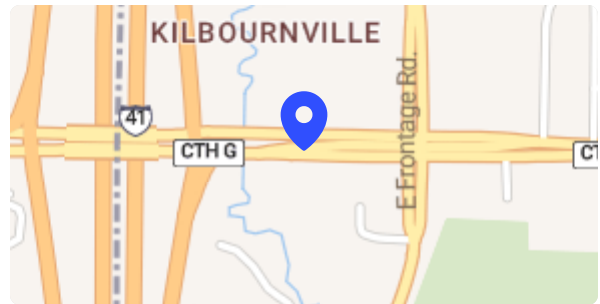

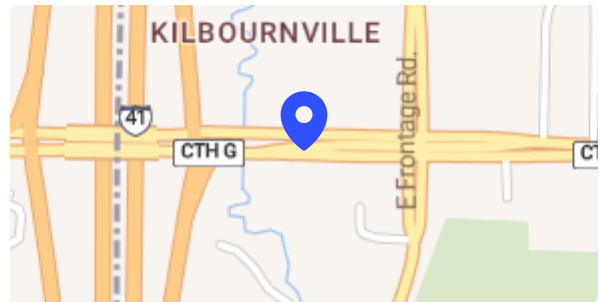

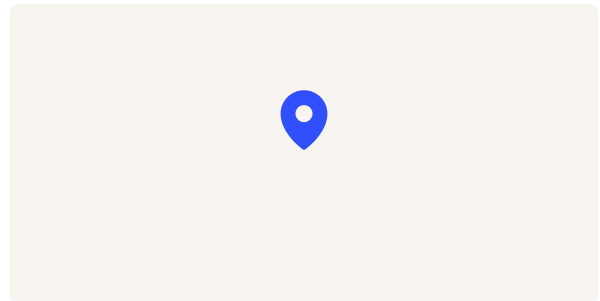
