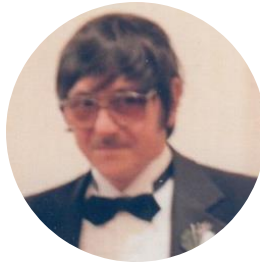

## Joseph Louis Marcsis

NOV 13, 1944 - OCT 20, 2018

**R**acine-Joseph (Joe) Marcsis, age 73, passed from this life after a valiant struggle on October 20, 2018, surrounded by loved ones.

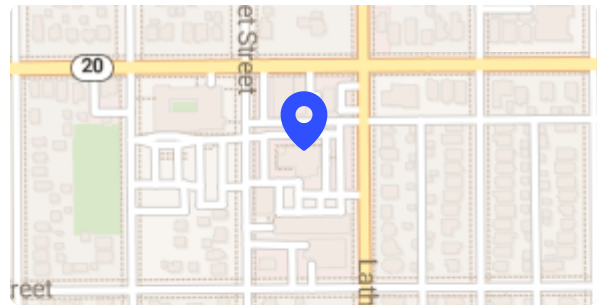

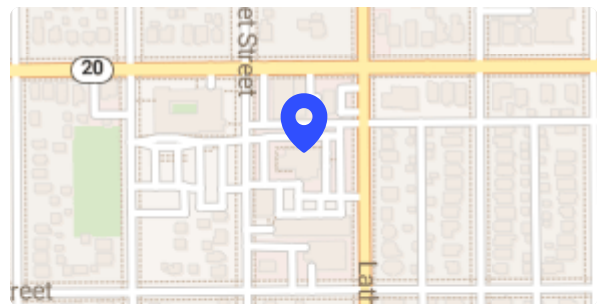

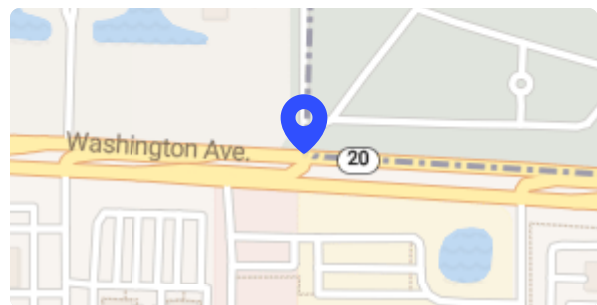
