A special thank you to the staff at St. Monica's Senior Living for their exceptional loving care given to Marian and her family.






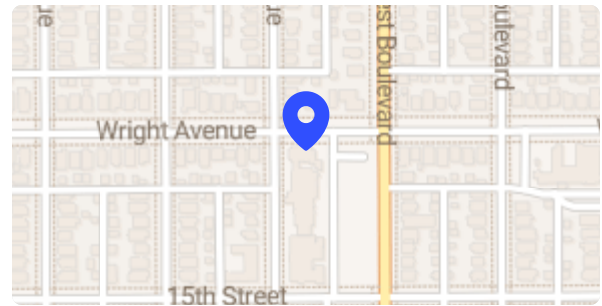

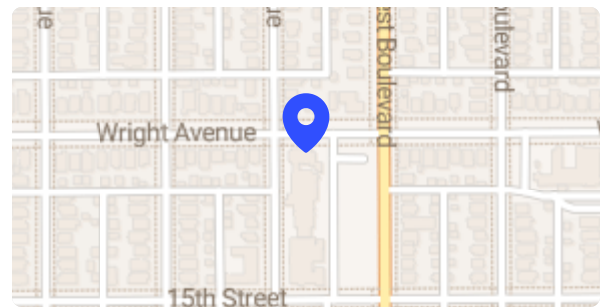

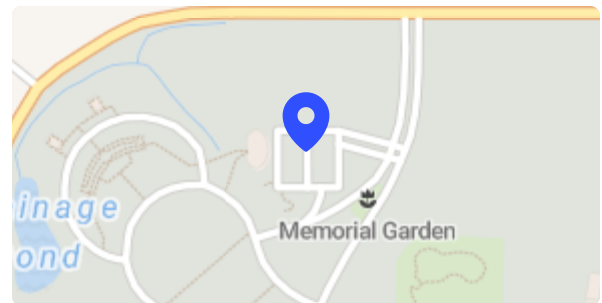
