Dean will be deeply missed by all who knew him, but his legacy of kindness, love, and service will live on in the hearts of his family and friends.



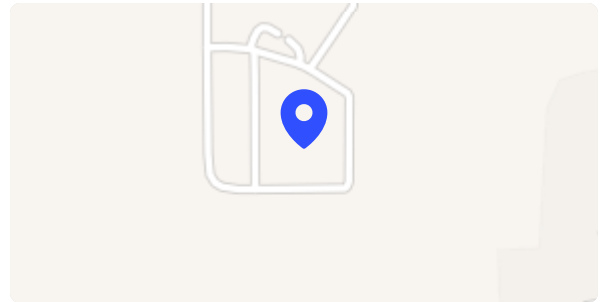

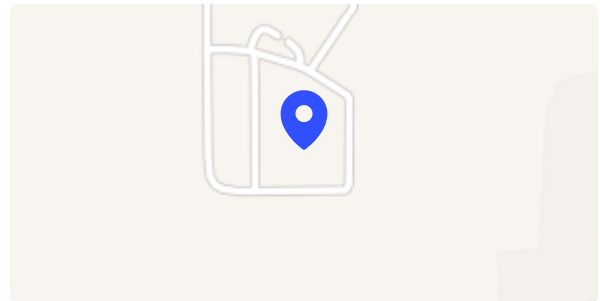

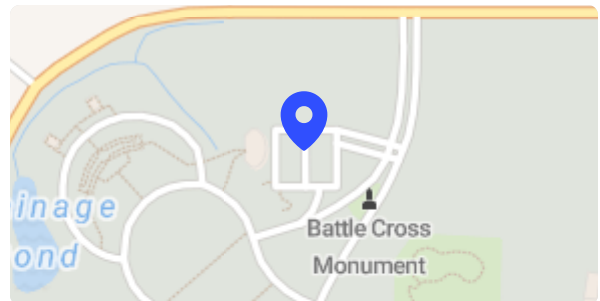
