Sullivan - Jodi Katherine Zwieg (nee: Francour), 44, passed away on January 20, 2010 at St. Luke's Hospital after a well fought, three year battle with esophageal cancer.

Jodi was born in Racine to Robert and Katherine (nee: Burdick) Francour on August 31, 1965. She lived in Racine for most of her life but moved to Sullivan in 2007. In Sullivan, she was united in marriage to Paul A. Zwieg on January 31, 2009.

Jodi received a degree from the University of Phoenix and was employed at Harley Davidson in the Human Resources Department for 17 years and retired on November 17, 2009 due to her illness. She was a member of the Harley Owners Group (HOG) and had a passion for motorcycling. She enjoyed camping and off roading with jeeps and had a love for dogs.
