# Mano Mastos

**E**agle, Wisconsin formerly of Racine - Mr. Mano T. Mastos, 92 years and ten months, passed away at his home in Eagle, Wisconsin on January 1, 2010.

Mano Mastos was born in Racine to the late Theodore and Aregina (nee: Prinias) Mestousis on March 1, 1917. In Racine, he was united in marriage to Virl Luccason on April 17, 1942 who preceded him in death on April 9, 2000.

Mr. Mastos was a life long member of the Kimissis Theotokou Greek Orthodox Church. He graduated from Washington Park High School. He was also a founding member of the Fifth Street Yacht Club. He was employed by Hendrick's Motors selling VW's in the 1960s and Young Radiator for 44 years until his retirement in 1979. His interests included boats, cars, and motorcycles. He enjoyed vacationing at their home in the north woods.
