Anthony “Tony” W. Mattson, age 79, passed away on December 12, 2025, in Kenosha, Wisconsin. Tony was born on October 31, 1946, in Hudson, Wisconsin. He attended the University of Wisconsin - Whitewater where he graduated with a degree in Accounting and met the love of his life, Kathleen Mattson (née Ontko). Tony and Kathleen were married on June 6, 1970, and together, they shared 55 wonderful years of marriage together. Tony began his career working as an accountant for various businesses before becoming self-employed and founding Mattson & Associates. He proudly operated his business until retiring in 2023.

Outside of work, Tony enjoyed taking trips up North, spending time fishing, golfing, taking pontoon cocktail cruises, and relaxing with appetizers and listening to music on the deck with family. He was a fan of the Packers, Brewers, Badgers, and the Whitewater Warhawks. 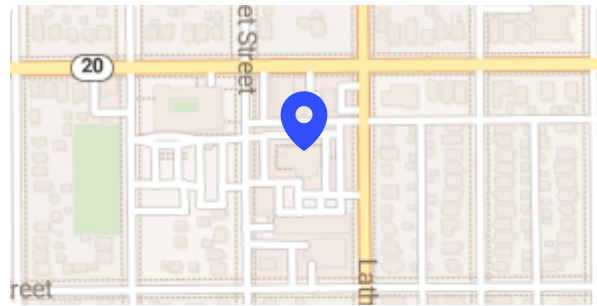
