Mt. Pleasant-Lyle Fred Erickson, 90, passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones on July 7, 2021.

Lyle was born on May 14, 1931, in New Auburn, Wisconsin to parents Oscar & Esther Erickson. He lived a full and blessed life, always laughing, never changing.
